



Scientific Missions Grant (SMG)

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Call opening: continuous

Decision and notification: continuous.

AIM

The SMG programme aims to strengthen research cooperation within the EuroEAP Society network. These missions enable scientists to visit institutions or laboratories to foster collaboration, learn new techniques, or conduct measurements using instruments and methods unavailable at their home institutions.

ELIGIBILITY AND CONSTRAINTS

- Membership Requirement: Applicants must be EuroEAP Society members with an active subscription at the time of submission.
- Eligible Applicants: Researchers affiliated with a research institution, including PhD students, may apply.
- Institutions Limit: To promote fair distribution and collaboration, only one SMG beneficiary per institution is allowed at a time.
- Visit Duration: The minimum duration of an SMG visit is one week. Longer visits are encouraged for greater research benefits.
- Financial Support: The maximum reimbursement amount is €1000.

EVALUATION OF THE GRANT PROPOSAL

The SMG Committee will peer review the application, soliciting opinions from external international experts where necessary.

The following selection criteria must be sufficiently addressed in the application:

- Scientific quality (state of the art, novelty and description of intended work (time plan));
- Benefit of SMG for applicant and host/Explanation why collaboration is necessary.

Failing to properly address these will lead to rejection of the application.
